April 2019 Day 1 - Tuesday 16 AUSTRALIA - CHRISTCHURCH

Join tour members at Adelaide, Brisbane, Melbourne or Sydney Airports for your flights to Christchurch. On arrival transfer to your hotel.

Day 2 - Wednesday April 17 CHRISTCHURCH

A morning visit to the impressive New Zealand **Air Force Museum** at Wigram Air Base. Enjoy a 'Behind the Scenes' Tour of the Museums' Restoration facility, and the Museum's unique record of New Zealand's military aviation history from the first official aircraft, the Bleriot XI, to the Skyhawk. Aircraft, memorabilia, photographs, documents and historic equipment follow the history from the First World War to the establishment of a Regular Air Force. Afterwards, time to explore Christchurch.

OVERNIGHT: CHRISTCHURCH

Day 3 - Thursday April 18 CHRISTCHURCH - BLENHEIM

An early morning departure aboard the **Coastal Pacific Train** to Blenheim. After crossing the Canterbury Plains, enjoy the panoramic views of the South Island's spectacular mountain & coastal scenery before your arrival in Blenheim, the Gourmet Province of Marlborough.

OVERNIGHT: QUALITY HOTEL BLENHEIM

Day 4 - Friday April 19 BLENHEIM Today you visit the Omaka Aerodrome, home of the Classic Fighters and one of the oldest aero clubs in NZ, for the aircraft practice day, & 'Trade Expo'. The day also gives you time to visit the Aviation Heritage Centre at Omaka, a destination the world-class for appreciation of historic aircraft, presenting the outstanding Knights of the Sky exhibition, Sir Peter Jackson's collection of WW1 aircraft & artefacts and the remarkable exhibit 'the Barons Last Flight'. This evening enjoy the Classic Fighters "Twilight Extreme" a twilight show of sunset flying, concert and fireworks display. A memorable start to the weekend.

OVERNIGHT: BLENHEIM

Days 5 & 6 BLENHEIM Saturday 20 & Sunday 21 April CLASSIC FIGHTERS 2019

bringing together warbird aircraft from all over New Zealand. Classic Fighters is more than an airshow, aircraft are displayed as part of a theatrical spectacle, where battle scenes from both World Wars are re-enacted on the ground as well as in the air. Marking the 125th Anniversary of New Zealand women's suffrage, the theme for Classics 2019 is 'Saluting Women in Aviation'.



'Saluting Women in Aviation'

See present day aviatrixes, participating in the show and learn of the roles played by women throughout the history of aviation & their significant contributions to the advancement of air travel. See and enjoy, the famous machines from the Great War dog-fighting overhead; mock airfield attacks by the glamour theatrical ground fighters of WW2; theatre battles with troops and vehicles in conjunction with aerial displays; formation aerobatics & historic aircraft displays; and displays by the Royal New Zealand Air Force. WW1 displays feature the Fokker Triplanes & Sopwiths, with a range of exciting antique and classic open cockpit biplanes and vintage cabin airlines representing the "Golden Age". The warbirds of WW2 include the iconic Spitfire, Mustang, and Kittyhawk, along with the PBY Catalina, DC3 and Harvards, to name a few. (Aircraft are subject to change). Against a backdrop of rolling hills, step back in time and experience the timeless atmosphere of Omaka Aerodrome. A spectacular weekend of fun and aviation in the Gourmet Province of Marlborough. an Airshow not to be missed.

Saturday morning option: visit Vine Village shops & Makana Chocolate Factory before arriving at the Airshow. OVERNIGHT: BLENHEIM

Day 7- Monday 22 April BLENHEIM - WELLINGTON

This morning we depart by coach to Picton to join the "*Interislander*" ferry service to the North Island & the Nation's Capital. The voyage has been described as "one of the most spectacular ferry rides in the world" and one of New Zealand's most iconic tourist experiences. On arrival in Wellington, we transfer to our hotel.

Day 8 - Tuesday 23 April WELLINGTON

A morning visit to the Nation's largest collection of classic motors, **Southward Car Museum**, housing a magnificent collection of over 400 vehicles, as well as three aircraft. Afternoon at leisure to explore Wellington

OVERNIGHT: WELLINGTON

Day 9 - Wednesday 24 April WELLINGTON - ROTORUA

This morning we travel to Waiouri to visit Zealand's National Army New Museum, NZ's most comprehensive Army Museum, showcasing a unique collection of military exhibits & memorabilia. Afterwards we continue to our Rotorua Hotel. This evening we enjoy a Village Maori evening experience and traditional feast.

OVERNIGHT: HOLIDAY INN ROTORUA

Day 10 - Thursday 25 April ROTORUA - AUCKLAND

A morning visit to the **TePuia Experience** -TeRa Maori Culture and Geothermal Wonders Tour. Explore the geothermal valley, showcasing the famous Rotorua mud pools and over 500 geothermal wonders, including the Pohutu Geyser. See New Zealand's native kiwi birds, and learn about Maori history & culture.

Afterwards we travel to Mount Maunganui, on the Bay of Plenty to visit the unique **Classic Fighters NZ Museum**, displaying a dynamic array of classic aircraft, antique engines, & aviation memorabilia from a bygone era. Late afternoon arrival in Auckland.

OVERNIGHT: GRAND MERCURE AUCKLAND

Day 11 - Friday 26 April AUCKLAND

A visit today to MOTAT, Auckland's Museum of Transport and Technology, to experience New Zealand's aviation history at the MOTAT Aviation Collection. in the Aviation Display Hall, including the only Solent Mark IV Flying Boat left in the world & a rare WWII era Avro Lancaster Bomber. Our visit includes a tour of the Blister Hangar, an aircraft restoration workshop. Afterwards we visit the Torpedo Bay Naval Museum, the National Museum of the RNZ Navy, which traces New Zealand's naval history since 1845. Displays include the RNZN's role in the World Wars, Korean War, Malayan Emergency, Vietnam War, Gulf War. the current War in Afghanistan, and the navy's contribution to the New **Zealand** peacekeeping force.

OVERNIGHT: AUCKLAND

Day 12 - Saturday 27 April AUCKLAND - AUSTRALIA

Transfer to Auckland Airport for your return flights to Adelaide, Brisbane, Melbourne or Sydney.

After October 30, 2018 the Tour Cost includes an Airshow General Admission 3 day Pass ticket. Gold Passes are available from Torii Tours if required at a supplement of \$245.00 per pass. The Gold Pass area is elevated grandstand seating for unobstructed viewing, directly in front of the runway, and a "Gold Pass" marguee where you can purchase food and refreshments. The Gold Pass provides entry to the enclosure on Friday, Saturday & Sunday & includes lunch from the Gold Pass marquee on Saturday & Sunday. The Pass also includes entry to the Aviation Heritage Centre.

Documentation
