Day 1 - Saturday 11 July 2020

AUSTRALIA - LOS ANGELES Join tour members at Sydney Airport for your American Airlines flight to the USA. We arrive the same day, after crossing the International and Date l ine transfer to the legendary Queen Mary, at Long Beach, for brunch. Afterwards we visit the March Field Air Museum, displaying one of the largest collections of military aircraft on the West Coast, to see early aircraft, including the 1903 pioneer which launched the era of powered flight, WWII bombing icons and Cold War fighters.

Day 2 - Sunday 12 July

LOS ANGELES - SAN DIEGO A morning visit to one of the world's largest aircraft collections, Yanks Air Museum, dedicated to exhibiting, preserving and restoring American aircraft and artifacts, including legends like the P-40 Warhawk and the F-86 Sabre. After a lunch stop at Flo's Airport Café, we visit the Planes of Fame Air Museum which maintains a fleet of flyable historic aircraft. The collection includes aircraft of the Great War of 1914-1918, planes from the Golden Age of the 1920s and 1930s, the warbirds of WWII and the jet age of the Korean & Vietnam Wars. The Museum is also home to the 475th Fighter Group hangar, a collection of stories from the group & displaying the Museum's flying Lockheed P-38J Lightning, the "23 Skidoo". Late afternoon transfer to San Diego, the birthplace of US naval aviation and home of the largest US Naval Base on the west coast, the principal homeport of the Pacific Fleet.

Day 3 - Monday 13 July SAN DIEGO A morning visit to the San Diego Air & Space Museum, an aviation and space exploration museum preserving & celebrating aviation and space flight history and technology. Afterwards a visit to the USS Midway Museum, to experience life at sea aboard one of America's longest-serving aircraft carriers & displaying more than 30 restored aircraft and helicopters on the Hangar and Flight Decks.

Day 4 - Tuesday 14 JulySAN DIEGOA day at leisure to explore San Diego.

Day 5 - Wednesday 15 July

SAN DIEGO - TUCSON An interesting day today as we travel by coach through the forests of southern California & the desert towns of Arizona to Tucson, "The Old Pueblo" and home of the old wild west.

Day 6 - Thursday 16 July

TUCSÓN - SCOTTSDALE A tour this morning of the 309th Aerospace Maintenance and Regeneration Group (AMARG), also known as the "Boneyard", the U.S. military and government aircraft storage facility at the famous Davis Monthan AFB. (subject to Base restrictions & security clearance) Afterwards we visit Pima Air & Space Museum, home of the Arizona Aviation Hall

of Fame and the 390th Memorial Museum, featuring the restored Boeing B-17 *Flying Fortress*. The Museum displays 100 years of Aviation history with nearly 300 vintage and current aircraft on display, including the ultimate flying machine, the famous Lockheed SR-71 *Blackbird* and the Boeing B-29 Superfortress *"Sentimental Journey"* of World War II fame. Late afternoon coach transfer through stark desert scenery to Scottsdale.

Day 7 - Friday 17 July SCOTTSDALE This morning we join a scenic aerial flight over the Grand Canyon. View Tonto National Forest; make a scenic pass through the Red Rock formations of Sedona; and soar past the San Francisco Peaks, Painted Desert and the Navajo Indian Reservation before experiencing one of the world's wonders, the Grand Canyon north & south rims from the air, one of nature's most spectacular sights. Afterwards we visit the Arizona Commemorative Air Force Museum Mesa, home of the B-17 and B-25 aircraft (subject to aircraft tour commitments). Experience the Working Maintenance Hangar and see the authentic collections of this rare combat museum.

Day 8 - Saturday 18 July SCOTTSDALE - DAYTON

A morning departure to Phoenix Airport for our flight to Columbus, Ohio. Transfer to the birthplace of Aviation, Dayton, home of the Wright Brothers, and known as the city that "taught the world to fly".

Day 9 - Sunday 19 July DAYTON Today is spent at the US Air Force Museum, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, the largest & oldest military aviation museum in the world. Exhibits include hundreds of aircraft and missiles from the days of the Wright Brothers, through the First and Second World Wars, the Cold War and Korea to the Space Age. Walk in the footsteps of presidents, astronauts, test pilots and those brought out of captivity in the Presidential Gallery, where the Museum's collection of Presidential aircraft are displayed. A Boeing VC-137C known as SAM (Special Air Mission) 26000, used by eight presidents & the aircraft that served as Air Force One on the day of President John F. Kennedy's assassination. In addition to Air Force One, you may walk through the presidential aircraft of Franklin D. Roosevelt, Harry Truman and Dwight Eisenhower; see the only remaining XB-70 Valkyrie; Bockscar - the Boeing B-29 Superfortress that dropped the atomic bomb on Nagasaki & the C-141C Starlifter "Hanoi Taxi", which airlifted the first American prisoners of war out of North Vietnam in 1973.

Day 10 - Monday 20 July DAYTON A morning visit to the *Wright Brothers Memorial and historic Huffman Prairie*, where the Wright Brothers perfected both their flying skills and their aircraft. Afterwards enjoy lunch at the *Engineers Club Dayton*, Wilbur and Orvilles Club, before visiting *Carillon Historical Park* an open air museum including the Wright Brothers National Museum and the 1905 Wright Flyer III, the first practical flying machine.

Day 11 - Tuesday 21 July

DAYTON - CHICAGO Departing Dayton, we travel by coach via the farmlands & cities of Indiana and Illinois to Oshkosh, your home for EAA AirVenture 2020.

Day 12 - Day 15 Wednesday 22 - Saturday 25 July OSHKOSH

Four days to enjoy the ultimate venue for aviation enthusiasts, Sport Aviation's World Capital - EAA AirVenture "The World's Greatest Aviation Celebration". The 68th Annual Convention will be home to hundreds of show planes and thousands of private aircraft will fill the transient aircraft parking area. From Jennies to Jets EAA has it all, Homebuilts, Antiques, Classics, Warbirds, Liaht Planes, Ultralights, Rotorcraft and Aerobatic aircraft. Walk along the flight line, visit the Forums area & the Exhibit Buildings, and enjoy the highlight of AirVenture, the daily afternoon Airshow spectacular. Evenings offer superb aviation programs and entertainment. A visit to the EAA AirVenture Museum; Pioneer Airport; and the picturesque AirVenture Seaplane Base are recommended. Oshkosh is a major tourist centre and a truly scenic area to explore.

A morning departure to Chicago O'Hare Airport for your return flights to Australia.
