



### JULY 2014 - Day 1 - Thursday 24 AUSTRALIA - OTTAWA

Join tour members at Sydney, Brisbane or Melbourne Airports for your Delta Airlines Flights to Los Angeles. Arrive the same day, after crossing the International Date Line and connect with your flights to Ottawa, Canada's capital city.

Day 2 - Friday 25 July
A morning visit to the Canada Aviation & Space Museum, Canada's national aviation museum presenting Canadian aviation achievements & recognized as having the most extensive aviation collection in Canada.

### Day 3 - Saturday 26 July OTTAWA

A day at leisure to explore Ottawa with your hop on hop off bus ticket. See the ceremonial Changing of the Guard at Parliament Hill; visit the Canadian War Museum, Canada's national museum of military history; Rideau Hall, home to the Governor General of Canada; Notre Dame Basilica, Byward Market & the famous landmarks & parks of the capital.

#### Day 4 - Sunday 27 July OTTAWA - NIAGARA FALLS

A morning coach transfer to Hamilton to visit the *Canadian Warplane Heritage Museum*, featuring aircraft used by Canadians & Canada's Military from the beginning of World War II up to the present day. Late afternoon arrival at Niagara Falls. Enjoy dinner at the Skylon Tower restaurant for spectacular views of the Falls by night.

### Day 5 - Monday 28 July NIAGARA FALLS- DAYTON

Join our catamaran cruise for a memorable and magnificent Niagara Falls tour experience, combining the water, power and mist of the majestic Falls. Afterwards we travel by coach to the birthplace of Aviation, Dayton, Ohio, home of the Wright Brothers, and known as the city that "taught the world to fly".

Day 6 - Tuesday 29 July
Today is spent at the *US Air Force Museum, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base,* the largest & oldest military aviation museum in the world. Exhibits include over 300 aircraft and missiles from the days of the Wright Brothers, through the First and Second World Wars, the Cold War and Korea to the Space Age. Our visit includes the *Presidential Gallery, (subject to government reopening schedule)* where the Museum's collection of Presidential & Experimental aircraft are displayed.

**Day 7 - Wed 30 July DAYTON - OSHKOSH** Today we tour by coach via Chicago and the farmlands & cities of Indiana to Oshkosh & the 2014 - **EAA AirVenture**.

### Day 8 - Day 10 OSHKOSH Thu 31 July - Sat 02 August

Three days to enjoy the ultimate venue for aviation enthusiasts, Sport Aviation's World Capital - *EAA AirVenture* "The World's Greatest Aviation Celebration". The 62nd Annual Convention at Wittman Regional Airport will be home to hundreds of show planes and thousands of private aircraft will fill the transient aircraft parking area. From Jennies to Jets EAA has it all, Homebuilts, Antiques, Classics, Warbirds, Light Planes, Ultralights, Rotorcraft and Aerobatic aircraft. Walk along the flight line, visit the Forums area & the Exhibit Buildings, and enjoy the highlight of AirVenture, the daily afternoon Airshow spectacular. Evenings offer aviation programs and entertainment. A visit to the EAA AirVenture Museum: Pioneer Airport; and the picturesque AirVenture Seaplane Base are recommended. Oshkosh is a major tourist centre and a truly scenic area to explore.

# Day 11 - Sunday 03 August OSHKOSH - WASHINGTON

This morning we depart Oshkosh to Milwaukee for our flights to the Nation's Capital - Washington DC.

## Day 12 - Monday 04 August

WASHINGTON

Enjoy a morning visit to *The National Museum of the Marine Corps*, Quantico, a lasting tribute to U.S. Marines - past, present, and future. Follow in the footsteps of Marines: from the yellow footprints that young recruits must fill at boot camp to the boot prints left in the sands of Pacific island beaches during World War II, in the snow of the Chosin Reservoir during the Korean War, and in the red dirt of Hill 881 South in Vietnam. This afternoon we visit the Smithsonian's museum, the "*Steven F Udvar-Hazy*"

**Center",** for the display and preservation of historic aviation and space artifacts, and home to the Paul E Garber collection. Watch air traffic at Dulles Airport from the observation tower, see the Space Shuttle "Enterprise", & the Boeing B-29 Superfortress "Enola Gay".

## Day 13 - Tuesday 05 August WASHINGTON

Today you visit the *Smithsonian National Air and Space Museum*, part of the great Smithsonian Institution. The museum offers visitors a dazzling array of flying machines and spacecraft never before assembled in one place. Exhibit areas house artifacts ranging from the Wright brothers' original 1903 Flyer and Lindbergh's "*Spirit of St. Louis*"; to a touchable Lunar rock sample; and the Apollo 11 command module *Columbia*.

You will also see dozens of airplanes, spacecraft, missiles, rockets and engines, all part of the historical and technological world of air and space flight. Afterwards time to explore the "Capital".

# Day 14 - Wednesday 06 August WASHINGTON - PHOENIX

A morning flight to the Valley of the Sun, Phoenix, Arizona. Afternoon at leisure to explore this exciting city.

Day 15 - Thu 07 August PHOENIX
This morning we travel through stark

This morning we travel through stark desert scenery to Tucson, for a tour of the 309th Aerospace Maintenance and Regeneration Center (309 AMARG), also known as the "Boneyard", at the famous **Davis Monthan AFB.** Afterwards we visit **Pima Air & Space Museum**,



home of the Arizona Aviation Hall of Fame and the 390th Memorial Museum, featuring the restored Boeing B-17G Flying Fortress & Douglas B-18B "Bolo" aircraft. The Museum displays 100 years of Aviation history with 300 vintage and current aircraft on display, including the ultimate flying machine, the famous Lockheed SR-71 Blackbird and the Boeing B-29 Superfortress "Sentimental Journey" of World War II fame. Late afternoon return to Phoenix.

**Day 16 - Friday 08 August PHOENIX** Today, a scenic flight to the *Grand Canyon*, to experience one of the world's wonders and to enjoy the Canyon from the air and on the ground.

# Day 17 - Saturday 09 August PHOENIX - SEATTLE

We transfer this morning to Phoenix Airport for our flight to the Emerald City - Seattle.

Day 18 - Sunday 10 August SEATTLE A morning visit the *Museum of Flight* where aviation history comes alive. From the first USA Airforce F-5 supersonic fighter to the cockpit of the first United Airlines mail plane, this unique facility allows you to experience, over 150 of the world's most awe-inspiring aircraft, dating from the dawn of aviation to the space age. Board America's first presidential jet -Air Force One, a Boeing VC-137B delivered to President Eisenhower in 1959; see the original jumbo jet - the prototype Boeing 747; British Airway's Concorde G-BOAG the last Concorde to make a commercial flight; and the Champlin Fighter Collection Display, one of the finest collections of historic fighters found anywhere in the world. Afternoon at leisure.

Day 19 - Monday 11 August SEATTLE Today we visit the Future of Flight Aviation Center, to experience the wonder of aviation technology, & the huge Boeing Everett Factory, where you can view 767, 747, 777, or 787 aircraft being assembled on the production line. This modern facility is the world's largest single building by volume, the final assembly area can accommodate six 747 and five 767 aircraft at the one time. This tour is a great introduction to the company that has more than 13.000 Boeing commercial ietliners in service. Afterwards we visit The Flying Heritage Collection showcasing the spectacular warbirds and technologies from 1935 - 1945. To complete an unforgettable day an exhilarating floatplane flight over the waterways of Seattle.

#### Day 20 - Tue 12 August SEATTLE - AUSTRALIA

Tonight, enjoy a Farewell dinner.

A morning at leisure in Seattle for last minute shopping, and to enjoy the city sights before our afternoon transfer to Seattle Airport for your flights to Australia via Los Angeles.

### **University Accommodation**
