Exercise Pitch Black & the WWII Bombing of Darwin

23 - 29 August, 2022



Day 1 - Tuesday 23 August 2022 DARWIN

Meet the Tour escort & Torii guests this afternoon at the Novotel Darwin CBD.

(Own arrangements to Darwin).

OVERNIGHT: DARWIN

Day 2 - Wednesday 24 August DARWIN
Today we experience the history of WWII in
Darwin, visiting the WWII Oil Storage
Tunnels, built to protect oil stored in Darwin
from Japanese bombing, and the Royal Flying
Doctor Service Tourist Facility, featuring the
RFDS Story and the Bombing of Darwin on
19th February, 1942. See also the remnants of
the war along the Darwin shoreline, aboard the
Bombing of Darwin Cruise boat.

Afterwards enjoy lunch at the **Trailer Boat Club**, *(own expense)*, before our visit to the **Darwin Military Museum**, featuring the powerful Defence of Darwin Experience, which highlights the 1942 bombing raids.

Day 3 - Thursday 25 August DARWIN
We transfer this morning to the perimeter of the
RAAF Base Darwin, to view the aircraft of the
exercise, departing and returning to the Base.
Exercise Pitch Black 2022 is the RAAF's most
significant International Engagement activity.
The exercise will host up to 2500 personnel
and up to 100 aircraft from around the globe,
including participants from Australia, Canada,
France, Indonesia, India, Singapore, Thailand,
Malaysia, UK, UAE, and the USA. Participating
fully for the first time, Germany, Japan, and the
Republic of Korea.

An afternoon visit to the **Darwin Aviation Museum**, displaying Darwin's aviation history and wartime experience,with aircraft including the legendary Boeing B52 G Stratofortress 92596 "Darwin's Pride", the only one in the Southern Hemisphere; the remnants of the Mitsubishi Zero gunned down during the first bombing of Darwin; the F-111C Strike Fighter; aircraft engines and rare amateur footage of the first air-raid in Darwin.

Afterwards view the aircraft from the Pitch Black Exercise, as they provide an aerial display at the **Mindil Beach** Sunset Markets.

Day 4 - Friday 26 August DARWIN
Morning visit to Charles Darwin National Park
to view the World War II—era concrete bunkers,
and displays. Travelling south along the Stuart
Highway, we stop at Strauss Airfield, one of
the last surviving and most intact WWII pursuit
fighter installations in northern Australia,
before visiting the Adelaide River War
Cemetery. A stop for lunch at the Adelaide
River Inn "303 Bar", where standing proudly is
"Charlie" the Buffalo, made famous by Mick
Dundee in the movie Crocodile Dundee.

Day 5 - Saturday 27 August DARWIN
Today is spent at the Pitch Black Open Day,
RAAF Base Darwin, to view the static displays
and to observe the capabilities of the
participating nations.

Day 6 - Sunday 28 August DARWIN
A day at leisure for you to explore & enjoy the sights of Darwin and the surrounding Northern Territory countryside.

Day 7 - Monday 29 August DARWINThe tour ends this morning, after breakfast, for your own travel arrangements home.
