**Day 1 - Tuesday** April 04  
**WELLINGTON**

Meet the Tour escort & Torii guests this afternoon at the Novotel Wellington. (Own arrangements to Wellington).

**OVERNIGHT: NOVOTEL HOTEL**

**Day 2 - Wednesday** April 05  
**WELLINGTON**

A morning visit to the Nation's largest private collection of classic motors, **Southward Car Museum**, housing a magnificent collection of over 400 vehicles from the early 1900's, and several aircraft. Time at leisure this afternoon to explore Wellington.

**OVERNIGHT: WELLINGTON**

**Day 3 - Thursday** April 06  
**WELLINGTON - BLENHEIM**

This morning we join the "Interislander" ferry service to the South Island and the picturesque port of Picton, gateway to the Gourmet Province of Marlborough. The voyage has been described as "one of the most spectacular ferry rides in the world" and one of New Zealand's most iconic tourist experiences. On arrival we transfer to **Hunter's Wines, Blenheim** for a light lunch and wine tasting.

**Day 4 - Friday April 07 BLENHEIM**

Today you visit the Omaka Aerodrome, home of the **Classic Fighters** and one of the oldest aero clubs in NZ, for the aircraft practice day, & 'Trade Expo'. The day also gives you time to visit the **Aviation Heritage Centre** at Omaka, a world-class destination for the appreciation of historic aircraft, presenting the outstanding *Knights of the Sky* exhibition, Sir Peter Jackson's collection of WW1 aircraft & artefacts, and the WW2 exhibit *'Dangerous Skies'*. This evening enjoy the **Classic Fighters "Twilight Extreme"** a twilight show of sunset flying, concert and fireworks display. A memorable start to the weekend.

**OVERNIGHT: BLENHEIM**

**Days 5 & 6** BLENHEIM  
**Saturday 08 & Sunday 09 April**

**CLASSIC FIGHTERS 2023**

celebrating over 20 years of spectacular flying, & bringing together warbird aircraft from all over New Zealand. **Classic Fighters** is more than an airshow, aircraft are displayed as part of a theatrical spectacle, where battle scenes from both World Wars are re-enacted on the ground as well as in the air.

See and enjoy, the famous machines from the Great War dog-fighting overhead; mock airfield attacks by the glamour fighters of WW2; theatrical ground theatre battles with troops and vehicles in conjunction with aerial displays; formation aerobatics & historic

aircraft displays; and displays by the Royal New Zealand Air Force. WW1 displays feature the Fokker Triplanes & Sopwiths, with a range of exciting antique and classic open cockpit biplanes and vintage cabin airlines representing the "Golden Age". The warbirds of WW2 include the iconic Spitfire, Mustang, Kittyhawk, and Harvards, to name a few. (refer to <https://www.classicfighters.co.nz/what-youll-see>) (Aircraft are subject to change). Against a backdrop of rolling hills, step back in time and experience the timeless atmosphere of Omaka Aerodrome. A spectacular weekend of fun and aviation in the Gourmet Province of Marlborough, an Airshow not to be missed.

**Saturday morning option:** visit Vine Village shops & Makana Chocolate Factory before arriving at the Airshow.

**OVERNIGHT: BLENHEIM**

**Day 7- Monday** April 10  
**BLENHEIM - CHRISTCHURCH**

After a leisurely breakfast we depart by coach to Christchurch. Enjoy the panoramic views of the South Island's spectacular scenery as we follow the rugged mountains along the coast to Kaikoura, New Zealand's renowned seal & whale watching area. Linger over a pleasant lunch while taking in the views of this sleepy Seaside village. Afterwards we continue across the coastal plains to Christchurch.

**OVERNIGHT: RYDGES LATIMER HOTEL**

**Day 8 - Tuesday** April 11  
**CHRISTCHURCH**

A morning visit to the impressive **Air Force Museum of New Zealand**, Wigram, the RNZAF's first operational base. Enjoy a 'Behind the Scenes' Tour of the Museums' Restoration facility, and the Museum's unique record of New Zealand's military aviation history from the first official aircraft, the Bleriot XI-2, to the Skyhawk. Aircraft, memorabilia, photographs, documents and historic equipment follow the history from the First World War to the establishment of a Regular Air Force. Time this afternoon to explore Christchurch.

**OVERNIGHT: CHRISTCHURCH**

**Day 9 - Wednesday** April 12  
**CHRISTCHURCH**

**The Tour ends after breakfast this morning**, for your own travel arrangements home. Airport transfers from the hotel to Christchurch Airport are included on April 12, 2023.

## → GOLD PASS

**Option 2: Gold Pass Grandstand.** The 3 Day Gold Pass area is elevated grandstand seating for unobstructed viewing, directly in front of the runway, and a “Gold Pass” marquee where you can purchase food and refreshments. The Gold Pass provides entry to the enclosure on Friday, Saturday & Sunday & includes lunch from the Gold Pass marquee on Saturday & Sunday.

Tea and coffee is complimentary.

A gift bag is included which will contain the printed air show programme and a selection of quality items. The pass also entitles the holder to one free admission to the *Knights of the Sky* exhibition at the Omaka Aviation Heritage Centre.

### Documentation
