Day 2 Thursday 28 CHRISTCHURCH - WANAKA

A morning visit to the impressive Air Force Museum of New Zealand. Enjoy a 'Behind the Scenes' Tour of the museums Restoration facility, & the museum's displays of New Zealand's military aviation history. Afterwards, enjoy the panoramic views of the South Island's spectacular scenery as we travel through the dramatically changing landscape of the Canterbury Plains and across Burkes Pass to Lake Tekapo, surrounded by the magnificent mountain scenery of the Southern Alps. We continue through Omarama and over the Lindis Pass to Tarras before our afternoon arrival in the picturesque Southern Lakes resort of Wanaka.

Day 3 - Friday 29 WANAKA

Today we visit Wanaka Airport for the Warbirds over Wanaka Practice Day in preparation of the weekend events, to see aircraft arrivals and Warbird, Civil and Military aircraft conduct practice displays. This afternoon we return to Wanaka for the Lakeside aircraft event, to view aerial displays over Lake Wanaka. Afterwards enjoy a Torii Beer & Burger evening at the lake front.

weekend to enjoy 17th the **WARBIRDS OVER WANAKA** International Airshow, ranked as one of the world's best Warbird Airshows, and acclaimed as the largest warbird air show in the Southern Hemisphere. The 2024 Airshow will offer visitors an unforgettable experience, with a combination of classic, vintage and veteran aircraft swooping and diving along the rivers, around the mountains and through the valley.

The Airshow programme for both days comprises some of the world's most iconic Warbird aircraft, together with classic aircraft of vestervear, modern

jets and helicopters of today. Displays by the Royal New Zealand Air Force, together with the dynamic flying of the aerobatic teams and the elite RNZAF Kiwi Blue parachute team, all completing an extravaganza of aerial action. Highlights include a spectacular mock airfield attack, Jet Racing, Joyrides, the new Future of Aviation Exhibition, Aviation Trade Stands and Market Stalls; displays of Military

Vehicles, Vintage Trucks and Vintage Machinery, and the regional Food & Wine Stalls. All the ingredients for a spectacular air show weekend - an Aviation Event not to be missed.

Late Sunday afternoon we join our coach transfer to Queenstown.

Day 6 - Monday 01 April QUEENSTOWN

A day at leisure to explore scenic Queenstown on the shores of Lake Wakatipu, set against the dramatic Southern Alps.

After breakfast we depart Queenstown to the quaint town of Te Anau, the gateway to Fiordland National Park and Milford Sound.

Day 8 - Wednesday 03 April TE ANAU

A tour highlight today with a visit to spectacular Milford Sound, a designated World Heritage Area. A morning coach departure via New Zealand's stunning & magnificent scenery to join our Milford Sound cruise. See seals basking on the rocks, dolphins, massive rock faces rising for hundreds of metres out of the sea and waterfalls cascading from ancient rainforests high in the mountains.

Day 9 - Thursday 04 April TE ANAU - DUNEDIN

This morning we visit the inspiring Croydon Aviation Heritage Centre, at the Old Mandeville Airfield, home of the golden age of flight, the 1920s and 30s, including an extensive collection of de Havilland aircraft. Aircraft on display include the Fox Moth, Dominie Rapid, Dragonfly and the Tiger Moth.

Afterwards we travel to Invercargill and the Bill Richardson Transport World, showcasing over 300 vintage vehicles. The collection includes classic Ford V8s, 1940 Texaco Tanker, Volkswagen Kombis & Classic cars & Trucks. Late afternoon arrival in Dunedin, a city known for its Scottish and Maori heritage, and Victorian & Edwardian architecture.
